# INTRODUCTION COPY

## NEW ZEALAND TRAFFIC SERVICE MEDAL BILL

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The effect of the Bill is to give recognition for years of service of traffic officers who, prior to incorporation of local or public authority traffic areas into the Ministry of Transport, served as local or public authority traffic officers.

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title and commencement. The Bill is to come into force on 1 May 1992.

Clause 2 amends clause 6 (1) (a) of the Royal Warrant relating to the New Zealand Traffic Service Medal (S.R. 1989/104) which sets out the eligibility for reckoning of years of service.

Clause 3 revokes clause 6 (1) (b) of the Royal Warrant which relates to counting a maximum of 7 years' service as a traffic officer with any local or public authority.

#### A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Royal Warrant relating to the New Zealand Traffic Service Medal to provide for the recognition of years of service of traffic officers who, prior to amalgamation of local or public authority traffic areas into the Ministry of Transport, served as local or public authority traffic officers

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Traffic Service Medal Act 1992.
  - (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1992.
  - 2. Amendment to reckoning of service—Paragraph (a) of clause 6 (1) of the Royal Warrant relating to the New Zealand Traffic Service Medal\* is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Ministry of Transport", the words "a local or public authority, or both".
  - **3. Repeal of provision for years of service with local or public authority**—Paragraph (b) of clause 6 (1) of the Royal Warrant relating to the New Zealand Traffic Service Medal is hereby revoked.
