# A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand University Act, 1908. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand

in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :—

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as the New Zealand University Short Title. Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand University Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2.) This Act shall commence on the first day of April, nine-Commencement. 10 teen hundred and *twenty*.

2. Section thirty of the principal Act is hereby amended by Making provision omitting the words "three thousand," and substituting the words for increased annual "four thousand."

- 3. Section thirty-one of the New Zealand University Amend-15 ment Act, 1914, is hereby amended-
  - (a.) By omitting from paragraph (a) the words "five thousand," and substituting the words "seven thousand five hundred ":
- **2**0 (b.) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words "five thousand," and substituting the words "seven thousand five hundred ":
  - (c.) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words "two thousand," and substituting the words "four thousand five hundred ":
  - (d.) By omitting from paragraph (d) the words "five thousand," and substituting the words "ten thousand."

4. In addition to the grants provided for by the said section Additional grants to thirty-one of the New Zealand University Amendment Act, 1914, as institutions for 30 amended by this Act, the Minister of Finance may in each year, without workers' extension further appropriation than this Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund to each of the four affiliated University Colleges the sum of five hundred pounds, to be applied exclusively to the purposes of workers' extension lectures, including tutorial classes, in University 35 subjects.
