EXPLANATORY NOTE

UNDER section 13 (b) of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1914 a candidate for a University National Scholarship must have been resident in New Zealand for three years immediately preceding the date of the award. The Bill removes this requirement, and substitutes a requirement that the candidate must be resident in New Zealand at the date of the award.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand University Act 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Short Title. University Amendment Act 1953, and shall be read See Reprint together with and deemed part of the New Zealand of Statutes, Vol. II, p. 1121 University Act 1908.

10 2. Section thirteen of the New Zealand University Residential Amendment Act 1914 is hereby amended by omitting quification from paragraph (b) the words "for the three years National immediately preceding", and substituting the word $\frac{\text{Scholarships.}}{\text{Scholarships.}}$ " at ".
