

NEW ZEALAND UNIVERSITY AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

UNDER section 13 (*b*) of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1914 a candidate for a University National Scholarship must have been resident in New Zealand for three years immediately preceding the date of the award. The Bill removes this requirement, and substitutes a requirement that the candidate must be resident in New Zealand at the date of the award.

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand University Act 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
