1. Short Title	

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the New Zealand University Act 1908

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the New Zealand
University Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together
with and deemed part of the New Zealand University Act
1908.*

10 **2. University National Scholarships**—(1) Paragraph (1)
of section 13 of the New Zealand University Amendment
Act 1914 (as substituted by paragraph (c) of subsection (1)
of section 3 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act
1950 and amended by paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of
15 section 4 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act
1956) is hereby further amended by omitting the words “one
hundred and seventy-five pounds”, and substituting the words
“two hundred and seventy-five pounds”.

(2) Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 4 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1956 is hereby consequentially repealed.

3. Power of Senate to grant additional degree—Subsection (1) of section 10 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1926 is hereby amended by adding the words “Bachelor of Food Technology”. 5
