A BILL INTITULED.

An Acr to amend "The University Act, 1874."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Zealand University Act 1874 Short Title. Amendment Act, 1883."
- 2. The Senate of the University of New Zealand shall have power, after Degrees may be examination, to confer the several degrees of Bachelor and Master in Arts, and granted in Arts, Law, Medicine, Science, and Doctor in Law Medicine, Science, and Music and auch research as Medicine, Science, Bachelor and Doctor in Law, Medicine, Science, and Music, and such reasonable and Music.

10 fees shall be charged for the degrees so conferred as the Senate shall from time to time direct.

This section shall be read with and be deemed to form part of "The New Zealand University Act, 1874."

3. "The New Zealand University Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1875," is Repeal. 15 hereby repealed.
