A BILL INTITULED:—

An Act to amend the Boundaries of the Province of Southland. Title.

WHEREAS the Governor in Council, by order made on the 25th day of March 1861, did establish the Province of Southland and define the boundaries thereof; and whereas the said boundaries exclude from the Province of Southland certain districts of country contiguous thereto which have a geographical unity with the said Province; and whereas certain of the inhabitants of those districts have petitioned that those districts shall be united politically to the Province of Southland; Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be the “Otago and Southland Boundary Act, 1862.” 1. Short Title.

II. The Boundary between the Provinces of Otago and Southland is hereby declared to be as follows:—Beginning on the south, on the coast at Brothers' Point, thence proceeding by a right line to the summit of Black Horn, thence by a right line to the summit of Black Hill, thence by a right line to the “Cairn,” near the source of Kawera, thence by a right line to the source of Kawera, thence by the Kawera to its junction with Waipaihi, thence by the Waipaihi to the point of its intersection by a right line drawn from the said junction of Kawera with Waipaihi to the summit of Black Umbrella, thence by a right line to the summit of Black Umbrella, thence by a right line to the Summit of White Umbrella, thence by a right line to the summit of White Comb, thence by a right line to the summit of Rocky Mount, thence by a right line to the southern end of Wakatipu Lake, thence by a line along the lake to its Northern end, thence by a right line to the northern end of Te Anau Lake, thence by the centre of the Te Anau Lake to the point where the river Waiau issues from the Lake, thence down the centre of the Waiau River (through the Manapori Lake) to the sea. 2. New Boundary between the Provinces of Otago and Southland.

III. The Secretary for Crown Lands shall, immediately after the passing of this Act, cause a plan of the boundary, as hereby defined, to be recorded in his office, and shall transmit authenticated copies thereof to the Superintendents of the Provinces of Otago and Southland respectively. 3. Plan of New Boundary to be recorded by Secretary of Crown Lands.
