A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to constitute the Otaki County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Otaki County Act, 1909.

Short Title.

2. (1.) The Otaki County is hereby constituted, comprising that Otaki County portion of the Horowhenua and Hutt Counties, particularly described constituted. in the First Schedule hereto, which at the date of the passing of 10 this Act comprised the Otaki and Te Horo Ridings of the said Horowhenua County and the Whareroa Riding of the said Hutt County.

(2.) The boundaries of the said Horowhenua County are hereby

altered as described in the Second Schedule hereto.

(3.) The boundaries of the said Hutt County are hereby altered

as described in the *Third* Schedule hereto.

3. The Otaki Road District is hereby abolished, and shall be Otaki Road District deemed to be merged in the Otaki County as constituted by this abolished. Act; and the provisions of section thirty-six of the Counties Act, 20 1908, shall be deemed to apply on the date of the coming into operation of this Act as if the said road district had merged into the said Otaki County under the provisions of the Counties

Act, 1908. 4. From and after the coming into operation of this Act no Jurisdiction of 25 local authority other than the said Otaki County Council shall, Otaki County Council. within the limits of the said county, exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under any Act:

Provided that nothing herein shall affect the power of the 30 Governor to proclaim any portion of the said county a borough or town district.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

BOUNDARIES OF THE OTAKI COUNTY.

ALL that area, situate in the Wellington Land District, bounded as follows: Commencing at a point on the sea-coast at the south-western corner of the Ohau No. 3 Block; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the Ohau No. 3 Block; thence northerly along the western boundary of Section 56, Block 9, Waiopehu Survey District; thence easterly along the northern boundaries of the said Section 56 and of Section 55, Block 10, Waiopehu Survey District; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of the said Section 55 to the north-western corner of the Muhunoa No. 2 Block; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said Muhunoa No. 2 Block to the point of intersection with the western boundary of the Masterton County; thence southerly and easterly along the south-eastern boundary of the Masterton County, and generally southerly along the western boundary of the Wairarapa South County, to the north-eastern corner of the Hutt County; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said Hutt County to a point where it intersects the eastern boundary of Section 2, Block 16, Kaitawa Survey District; thence southerly along the said eastern boundary of the said Section 2, and the eastern boundaries of Section 3, Block 16, Kaitawa Survey District, and of Sections 9, 10, 11, and 12, Block 3, Akatarawa Survey District, to the north-eastern boundary of Section 6, Block 3; thence generally westerly along the northern boundaries of the said Section 6 and of Section 2, Block 3, Akatarawa Survey District, to the eastern boundary of Section 407, Block 2, Akatarawa Survey District; thence northerly along part of the eastern boundary of the said Section 407 to the northern boundary of the same section; thence south-westerly along the northern boundary of the said Section 407 and of Section 406, Block 2, Akatarawa Survey District to the western boundary of the said Section 406; thence southerly along part of the said western boundary to the north-eastern corner of Section 5, Block 2, Akatarawa Survey District; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the said Section 5 to the eastern boundary of Section 15, Block 1, Akatarawa Survey District; thence southerly along the eastern boundary and westerly along the southern boundary of the said Section 15 to the north-eastern corner of the forest reserve in Blocks 1, 5, and 9, Akatarawa Survey District; thence southerly along the said eastern boundary of the said forest reserve to the northern boundary of Section 2, Block 9, Akatarawa Survey District; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of the said Section 2, and of Sections 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2 of Block 7, Paikakariki Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of Section 64, Block 7, Paikakariki Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of the said forest reserve to a point where the said western boundary is intersected by a straight line formed by the continuation in an easterly direction of the southern boundary of the Tunupo Block; thence easterly along the said straight line to the easternmost corner of the said Tunupo Block; thence northwesterly along the northern boundary of the said Tunupo Block to the sea-coast; thence generally north-easterly along the sea-coast to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Boundaries of the Horowhenua County.

ALL that area, situate in the Wellington Land District, bounded as follows: Commencing at the south-western corner of the Ohau No. 3 Block; thence northerly along the sea-coast to the mouth of the Manawatu River; thence easterly, northerly, and easterly along the said river to the point where the southern boundary of the Kairanga County intersects the said river; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said Kairanga County to the point of intersection of the said Kairanga County with the Eketahuna County; thence southerly, south-westerly, and generally southerly along the western boundaries of the said Eketahuna County and the Mauriceville and Masterton Counties to the northern boundary of the Muhunoa No. 2 Block; thence westerly along part of the northern boundary of the said Muhunoa No. 2 Block to the eastern boundary of Section 55, Block 10, Waiopehu Survey District; thence northerly along part of the said eastern boundary

to the north-eastern corner of the said Section 55; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the said Section 55 and of Section 56, Block 9, Waiopehu Survey District, to the north-western corner of the said Section 56; thence southerly to the north-eastern corner of Section 58, Block 9, Waiopehu Survey District; thence westerly along the southern boundary of the Ohau No. 3 Block to the point of commencement.

THIRD SCHEDULE.

Boundaries of the Hutt County.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded as follows: Commencing on the sea-coast at the north-western corner of the Tunupo Block; thence easterly, southerly, easterly, northerly, generally north-easterly, northerly, and easterly, by the Otaki County, more particularly described in the First Schedule hereto, to the summit of the Tararua Range; thence southerly along the summit of the Tararua and Rimutaka Ranges to Cape Turakirae; thence westerly by the sea and northerly by Port Nicholson to the south-western corner of the Borough of Petone; thence westerly by Port Nicholson and generally northerly by the Makara County to the Porirua Harbour; thence along the Porirua Harbour and the sea in a northerly direction to the point of commencement: excluding, however, the Boroughs of Lower Hutt, Petone, and Eastbourne.
