Title. Preamble. Short Title. 2. Vesting of lands in Schedule B.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to vest in the Otago District (Hospital) Board, as an Endow-Title. ment for Hospital Purposes, a Portion of certain Lands at present vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Kaitangata as an Endowment in Aid of the Borough Funds.

WHEREAS the pieces of land hereinafter described in Schedule A Preamble. are vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Kaitangata (hereinafter called the Borough Council) as an

10 endowment in aid of the borough funds: And whereas the Borough Council entered into an agreement with the Otago District (Hospital) Board (hereinafter called the Hospital Board) that the Hospital Board should erect a Hospital on the said piece of land described in Schedule B, being part of the land described in Sche-

15 dule A, and that such Hospital should be maintained and controlled by the Hospital Board; and in consideration thereof the Borough Council agreed to make a contribution to the said Hospital, and to take immediate steps to have the said piece of land described in Schedule B vested in the Hospital Board for hospital purposes:

20 And whereas the said pieces of land described in Schedule A are leased to the New Zealand Coal and Oil Company (Limited) (hereinafter called the company) under Memorandum of Lease Registered Number 1668: And whereas it is greatly to the benefit of the company that the said Hospital should be established at

25 Kaitangata: And whereas the company agreed that in consideration of the Hospital Board erecting the said Hospital the company would make a contribution towards the maintenance of the said Hospital, and also would release the piece of land described in Schedule B from the said memorandum of lease: And whereas the Hospital

30 Board has erected the said Hospital on the said piece of land, and the Borough Council and the company are now desirous that the

said piece of land should be vested in the Hospital Board for hospital purposes freed from the said memorandum of lease to the company:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

Vesting of lands in Schedule B.

District Land Registrar to cancel existing certificate and issue fresh ones. 1. This Act may be cited as the Otago District (Hospital) Board Kaitangata Reserve Vesting Act, 1909.

2. Immediately on the passing of this Act the land described in Schedule B shall, without any conveyance or other assurance, vest in the Otago District (Hospital) Board freed from the existing 10 trusts and from the said Memorandum of Lease Registered Number 1668, and shall be held in future as a reserve for hospital purposes.

3. The District Land Registrar of the District of Otago shall cancel the certificate of title of the land described in Schedule A, and without charge issue a new certificate of title to the Hospital 15 Board for the land described in Schedule B, and such certificate shall state that the said piece of land is vested in the Hospital Board for hospital purposes; and also shall issue a new certificate of title to the Borough Council for the balance of the said land described in Schedule A, subject to the trusts and incumbrances declared in or 20 noted on the old certificate of title respecting the said land.
