- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Otago Harbour Board Further Short Title. Empowering Act, 1882."
- 2. It shall be lawful for the Otago Harbour Board, and it is hereby Otago Harbour Board authorized, to raise and borrow from time to time, in addition to any money already borrowed, a sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole three £30,000.
- 3. This Act shall be deemed a special Act within the meaning of section one Act to be deemed a special Act.
