Title. 1. Short Title. Courts may permit publishing in certain case.
Repeal. 2. Names of first offenders not to be published.

## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Offenders Probation Act, 1920.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Offenders Probation Amendment Short Title. Act, 1929, and be cited together with the Offenders Probation Act, 1920.

2. The name of a first offender, or any reference to his occupation Names of or address sufficient to disclose his identity, shall not be published, first offenders not to be published. 10 except as directed in the next succeeding section.

3. On the conviction of a first offender the Court may permit the Courts may publication of his name, address, or description if it is of opinion that permit publishing in certain cases. such publication, owing to the nature of the offence, the disposition of the offender, his acting in combination with others in committing the

15 offence, or for any other reason whatever, it is desirable, in the interest of the public, that the offender should be known.

4. This Act is in substitution for section nine of the Offenders Repeal. Probation Act, 1920, and that section is hereby accordingly repealed.
