A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorize the Governor to make Crown Title. grants of certain Crown Lands in the Province of Otago, and for other Purposes.

WHEREAS the parcels of land described in the several Schedules Preamble. hereto have been by the Superintendent of the Province of Otago on the recommendation of the Provincial Council thereof reserved for the respective purposes mentioned in the said Schedules: And whereas as to some of the said parcels of land doubts have arisen whether the purposes for which the same have been reserved are purposes for which reserves of Crown Lands may be made by such Superintendent and as to other of the said lands reserved as endowments doubts have arisen whether the same are held under 10 pastoral leases or licenses the same can be reserved without determining such leases or licenses: And whereas it is expedient nevertheless that authority should be given to the Governor to make Crown grants of all the said lands to the Superintendent to be subject to be dealt with under "The Public Reserves Act 1854" 15 and "The Public Reserves Act Amendment Act 1862" but without power to sell the same without the authority of an Act of the General Assembly: And that as to such of the said lands as were at the time of such reservation held under pastoral leases or licenses that the reservation thereof should not determine or affect such licenses or 20 leases:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Otago Reserves Short Title. 25 Act 1871."

No. 106—1.

Governor authorized to issue Crown grants to Superintendent of lands in Schedule. 2. It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause Crown grants of the lands described in the several Schedules hereto to be made to the Superintendent of Otago upon trust for the respective purposes specified in the said Schedules The description of the several pieces of lands is in the said Schedules set forth immediately after the specification of the purposes for which they are to be granted.

Reserves to be subject to Public Reserves Acts. 3. The said lands shall except as hereinafter contained be held and dealt with under and be subject to the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act 1854" and "The Public Reserves Act Amendment Act 1862."

Except that Provincial Council not to pass law authorizing the sale or other alienation for longer than twenty-one years.

But notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Acts or either of them it shall not be lawful for the Provincial Council to pass or the Superintendent to assent to any Ordinance or Act authorizing the sale of such lands or any of them or any lease or other alienation or disposition thereof for a longer period than twenty- 15 one years either by the Superintendent or any commissioner corporation trustees or other body or persons.

Pastoral leases not to be determined by reservation for endowments. 4. As to such of the said lands as were at the time of such reservation held under lease or license it is hereby declared and enacted that notwithstanding such reservation such leases or licenses were 20 not and are not determined thereby but shall be deemed to have been and continued and shall be and continue in force notwithstanding such reservation.
