A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the granting to the Governing Title. Body of the Town of Onehunga certain Reserves within that Town.

THEREAS certain reserves in the Town of Onehunga are at Preamble. present lying waste there, and it is advisable that the same

- 5 address be presented to His Honor the Superintendent, requesting that, with a view to the utilization of the reserves at Onehunga, the management of these reserves should, as soon as practicable, be entrusted to the governing body of that town, and that the specific purposes of the
- 10 several endowments should be those set opposite each allotment": And it is expedient to give effect to the resolution above quoted :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

151. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Onehunga Reserves Short Title. Act, 1875."

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause grants from the Governor may grant Crown of the several allotments of land described in the Schedule purposes specified to hereto to be issued to the governing body for the time being of the governing body of the Town of One-

3. It shall be lawful for the said governing body from time to Governing body may time to demise all or any of the lands specified in the Schedule hereto, Schedules.

25 or any part or parts thereof, at such annual rent or rents, and for such How rents and term of years not exceeding twenty-one years, as the said governing of body may think fit; and the rents issues and profits arising out of the No. 126-1.

lands specified in the Schedule hereto as endowments for the benefit of the Town of Onehunga shall form part of the ordinary local revenue of the said town; and the rents issues and profits arising out of the land specified in the Schedule as harbour endowments shall be held and applied to and for improving the said harbour.

But it shall not be lawful for the said governing body to demise or lease, or apply to any other purpose than the purpose in each case particularly expressed, any of or any part of the lands described in the Schedule as a reserve for a public garden and public recreation, or those described as water reserves. 10

4. The control and management of the reserves shall thenceforth vest in the governing body; and it shall be the duty of the governing body to keep separate accounts of rents issues and profits arising from the town and harbour endowments respectively, and devote the same to the purposes expressed in the respective grants.

5. Subject to the purposes and trusts for which the endowments mentioned in the Schedule have been granted to the said governing body it shall be lawful for such governing body to let from time to time, for any period not exceeding twenty-one years, all or any portion of the endowments hereby authorized to be granted, and to fence the same or any part thereof, and to do all such acts as they may deem 20 necessary for the management and improvement thereof, and to apply all rents to be received therefrom in such way as such governing body may think fit for the improvement of the several endowments, subject always to the provisions of this Act.

6. It shall be lawful for the governing body, with the consent of 25 the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, to borrow or take up money by way of loan, for the purpose of defraying expenses connected with the improvement of the endowments, at any rate of interest not exceeding eight pounds per centum per annum, which loans, together with the interest accruing thereon, shall be a first charge on the 30 specific endowments on the security of which such loan shall have been raised.
