A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the vesting of certain Reserves within
the Town of Oamaru. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to vest the parcels of land described in
the Schedules to this Act as hereinafter expressed : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Oamaru Reserves
Act, 1877." Short Title.

2. The lands described in the First Schedule shall be and they
are hereby vested in Her Majesty the Queen, and shall be reserved for
any public purpose connected with the Government of the colony
which may be determined by the Governor in Council. Lands in First
Schedule vested in
Queen.

3. The lands described in the Second Schedule shall be and they
are hereby vested in Her Majesty the Queen, and shall be reserved as
a site for courthouse and police station. Lands in Second
Schedule vested in
Queen.

4. The lands described in the Third Schedule shall be and they
are hereby vested in Her Majesty the Queen, and shall be reserved as
a site for a public gaol. Lands in Third
Schedule vested in
Queen.

5. The parcel of land described in the Fourth Schedule shall be
and the same is hereby vested in the Trustees of the Oamaru
Athenæum and Mechanics' Institute and their successors, upon the
same trusts affecting other lands vested in the said Athenæum. Lands vested in
Trustees, Athenæum.

6. The lands described in the Fifth Schedule shall be and the
same are hereby vested in the Corporation of the Town of Oamaru, in
trust for municipal purposes. Lands vested in
Corporation.

7. It shall be lawful for the Corporation of Oamaru to manage
the lands in the Fifth Schedule, and to lease the same or any of them
for any term not exceeding twenty-one years, and subject to such con-
ditions and stipulations as the said Corporation shall think fit, but so
that nothing shall be taken in the nature of a fine or premium. Corporation may
lease.

8. The rents, issues, and profits arising from the said lands
described in the said Fifth Schedule shall be received and applied by
the said Corporation as the general funds of that Corporation may by
law for the time being be applied or disposed of by the said Cor-
poration.

9. The said Corporation will, when required so to do by the
Governor of the Colony, expend in the erection of a gaol on the parcel
of land described in the Third Schedule, a sum not greater than
five thousand pounds, and they shall be allowed to appropriate such
money out of the municipal fund or out of loan. Corporation to
expend money on
gaol.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Town of Oamaru, in the Provincial District of Otago, being Section 5, Block XXV., on the record map of the said town. Bounded towards the North-east by Section 4; towards the South-east by Severn Street; towards the South-west by Section 5; and towards the North-west by Sections 31 and 32.

All that parcel of land in the Town of Oamaru, being Sections 6 and 7, Block XXV., on the record map of the said town. Bounded towards the North-east by Section 5; towards the South-east by Severn street; towards the South-west by Sections 8 and 27; and towards the West by Sections 29, 30, and 31.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situated in Block XCV., in the Town of Oamaru, and being part of such block, containing by admeasurement two (2) roods and twenty (20) poles. Bounded as follows:—Commencing at a point in the eastern boundary line of said block, distant in a southerly direction seven hundred and twenty-five five-tenths (725⁵/₁₀) links from the northern corner of said block; thence running southerly along said boundary lines, two hundred and fifty (250) links; thence by a line at right angles, two hundred and fifty (250) links; thence by a line at right angles, two hundred and fifty (250) links; thence by a line at right angles home to the commencing point, two hundred and fifty (250) links.

THIRD SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Town of Oamaru, containing by admeasurement three (3) acres one (1) rood and eighteen (18) poles, more or less, being part of Reserve D on the map of the said town. Bounded towards the North by a line in continuation of the south side of Chelmer Street, eight hundred and sixty (860) links; towards the East by Wye Street, three hundred and forty-eight (348) links; towards the South by the Railway Reserve, four hundred and seventy-nine (479) links and six hundred (600) links; and towards the West by a street forming the boundary of the town, five hundred and thirty-seven (537) links; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on the plans deposited in the Provincial District Survey Office, Dunedin.

FOURTH SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situated in Block XCV., Town of Oamaru, and being part of said block. Bounded as follows:—On the South by Section 6, two hundred and fifty (250) links; on the East by Thames Street, fifty-one and five-tenths (51⁵/₁₀) links; on the South by other part of the said Block No. XCV., two hundred and fifty (250) links; and on the West by other part of said block, fifty-one and five-tenths (51⁵/₁₀) links.

FIFTH SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Town of Oamaru, being Section 27, Block XXV., on the record map of the said town. Bounded towards the North-east by Sections 28, 29, and 7; towards the South-east by Section 8; towards the South-west by Section 26; and towards the North-west by Reed Street.

All that parcel of land being Sections 8 and 9, Block XXV., on the record map of the Town of Oamaru. Bounded as follows:—Towards the North-east by Section 7; towards the South-east by Severn Street; towards the South-west by Section 10; and towards the North-west by Sections 26 and 27.

All that parcel of land in the Town of Oamaru, being part of Block No. XCV., containing by admeasurement two (2) acres two (2) roods and twenty-four (24) perches. Bounded by lines running as follows:—Commencing at the northern corner of said block; thence along Severn Street in a southerly direction, seven hundred and twenty-six (726) links; thence south-easterly along the School Reserve, four hundred and thirty (430) links; thence running easterly along the Drill-shed Reserve, one hundred and twenty-eight (128) links; thence running westerly along the parcel of land described in the Third Schedule, two hundred and one and five-tenths (201⁵/₁₀) links; thence running easterly by the said parcel of land, two hundred and fifty (250) links; thence running northerly along Thames Street to the commencing point, seven hundred and twenty-five and five-tenths (725⁵/₁₀) links.
