AN ACT to make Provision for altering the Constitution Title. of the Ohai Railway Board.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Ohai Railway Board Short Title. Amendment Act, 1947, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Ohai Railway Board Act, 1932

10 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing Provision for section four, and substituting the following section:— $appointment_{of two}$

"4. (1) Of the members of the Board two shall be members of appointed by the Minister of Mines and one shall be the Board by the Minister 15 elected by the coal-owners.

"(2) The members of the Board, other than any member appointed under this section, shall be elected in the manner prescribed by the Local Elections and Polls Act, 1925, all the provisions of which Act shall, so far as they are not inconsistent with the principal 5 Act or this Act, apply accordingly.

"(3) Each member of the Board appointed under this section shall hold office during the pleasure of the Minister of Mines, and, if for any reason the office of any such member becomes vacant, the Minister of Mines 10 may appoint a member in the place of such beforementioned member."

3. Section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "person" in paragraph (b), the words "(other than the Crown)". 15
