

## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the operation of “The Public  
Domains Act 1860” as amended by “The Public  
Domains Act Amendment Act 1865.”

**W**HEREAS by “The Public Domains Act 1860” it is enacted that  
the lands specified in the Schedule thereto and lands which may with  
lawful authority be set apart by Her Majesty or by the Governor in  
the name of Her Majesty for the purposes of the said Act are thereby  
5 declared to be Crown Lands subject to the provisions of the said Act  
and to be managed administered and dealt with by the Governor in  
the manner therein set forth And whereas by “The Public Domains  
Act Amendment Act 1865” the said first-mentioned Act is amended  
10 in certain respects And whereas it is expedient to bring the parcels  
of land respectively specified and described in the Schedule hereto  
under the provisions of the said Acts

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same  
as follows :—

15 1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Public Domains  
Acts Extension Act 1868.”

2. The parcels of land respectively specified and described in the  
Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be Crown Lands subject to  
the provisions of “The Public Domains Act 1860” as amended by  
20 “The Public Domains Act Amendment Act 1865” and shall be  
managed administered and dealt with by the Governor as directed by  
the said Acts in the same manner to all intents and purposes as if the  
said parcels of land had been included and specified in the Schedule  
to “The Public Domains Act 1860” and therein declared to be Crown  
25 Lands subject to the provisions thereof.

### SCHEDULE.

#### I.

ALL that parcel of land in the City of Wellington comprising one (1) acre more or less  
bounded on the North by a line starting from the north-west corner of Lawrence Street  
at its junction with Sydney Street (one thousand and thirteen (1013) links from the  
intersection of that street with Molesworth Street) one hundred and ninety-two (192)  
links in length along Sydney Street to the north-east corner of section five hundred and  
three (503) as re-arranged by the Colonial Government and the owner of that section  
thence on the West by four hundred and thirty-seven (437) links along the eastern  
boundary of that section now the property of Walter Baldock Durant Mantell and  
from that point on the South-west by a line of one hundred and six (106) links along  
part of section five hundred and three (503) to Kumutoto Street thence on the South  
by one hundred and thirty-two (132) links along that street to its junction with  
Lawrence Street and from that point on the East by five hundred and twenty-four  
(524) links along the west side of Lawrence Street to its junction with Sydney Street  
being the point of commencement.

#### II.

All that parcel of land in the City of Wellington comprising two (2) acres one  
(1) rood and twenty-four (24) perches more or less bounded on the South-east by a  
line starting from the south-east corner of section six hundred and twenty-nine (629)  
four hundred (400) links in length along the Tinakori Road thence on the North-east  
by six hundred (600) links along the south-west boundary line of section six hundred  
and thirty-two (632) now belonging to Charles Harrison to Grant Road thence on the  
North-west by four hundred (400) links along Grant Road to the north corner of  
section six hundred and twenty-nine (629) and from that point by six hundred (600)  
links along the north-east boundary line of that section now belonging to Joseph  
George Holdsworth to the point of commencement.

#### III.

All that parcel of land in the City of Wellington known as the Botanical Garden  
Reserve comprising thirteen (13) acres three (3) roods and thirty-six (36) perches  
more or less bounded on the West by a line starting from the north-west corner of the  
Upland Farm two hundred and seventy-five (275) links long to the Karori Road (being  
a production until they meet of the south-west boundary lines of that farm and a  
Native Reserve) and thence by thirty-one (31) chains along that road to the south-west  
corner of the Wesleyan College Reserve abutting on the Karori Road thence on the  
North by three hundred and thirty-nine (339) links along that reserve and from that  
point on the East by twenty-eight (28) chains seventy-five (75) links along the north-  
west boundary line of the same reserve to the Upland Farm and thence on the South  
by three hundred and forty-eight and a half (348½) links along the north boundary of  
that farm to the point of commencement.
