## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Poisons Importation and Carriage Act, Title. 1895."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Poisons Importation and Short Title. Carriage Amendment Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Poisons Importation and Carriage Act, 1895"

10 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act").

2. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in the principal Act, it shall Carriage of be lawful to import or send to any port or place in New Zealand sheep-dip in powder although containing arsenic or compounds of

arsenic if securely packed in wooden boxes.

15. (2.) Subject to the *last preceding* subsection, the provisions of the principal Act shall apply to sheep-dip containing over ten per centum of arsenic or compounds of arsenic.
