A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Police Offences Act, 1884."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Police Offences Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Police Offences Act, 1884" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

Short Title.

2. Section sixteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words "to public view."
