Permanent Officers' Salaries.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Annual Appropriation of the Salaries payable to the Holders of certain Permanent and other Offices.

WHEREAS it is expedient that upon the person who at present holds any of the offices mentioned in the First Schedule hereto ceasing to hold such office, the salary from time to time thereafter payable to the holder of such office should be annually appropriated :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Permanent Officers' Salaries Act, 1872."

2. Notwithstanding any of the Acts or parts of Acts mentioned in the Second Schedule to the contrary, upon the person who at present holds any of the offices mentioned in the First Schedule hereto ceasing to hold such office, the salary from time to time thereafter payable to the holder of such office shall be such as shall from time to time be fixed by the General Assembly, and shall be subject to annual appropriation by the General Assembly.
