PUBLIC RESERVES ACT AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

Title.

AN ACT to amend "The Public Reserves Act, 1881."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Reserves Act Amendment Act, 1889." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Public Reserves Act, 1881," herein referred to as "the said Act," the Governor, by notification in the *Gazette*, may declare that any 10 land comprised within a reserve in classes one or two shall, from a date to be specified in the said *Gazette*, be appropriated for the purposes of a reserve under class three of the said Act; and thereafter the law affecting reserves in the said class three shall apply to any land so appropriated as aforesaid. Governor may transfer reserve in Classes 1 or 2 to reserve in Class 3.
