"The Victoria College Act, 1905." 2. The Colonial Treasurer shall, without further appropriation Treasury to pay 10 than this Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund to the Council after Queen's Scholar-ships. the end of each quarter the amounts payable to the holders of junior

and senior Queen's Scholarships.

3. Section thirty-seven of "The Victoria College Act, 1905," is Section 37 of hereby amended by repealing the words "(including all expenses of principal Act amended. 15 and incidental to the Queen's Scholarships)," and also the words "two hundred."
