2. (1.) The decision of the Assessment Court constituted under Decision of Assess-10 the principal Act shall be final on all objections as to value, but not ment Court final as to value only. on other questions.

(2.) On all such other questions there shall be a right of appeal, exercisable in the manner and subject to the limitations and consequences prescribed by sections eighteen to twenty-four of "The 15 Government Valuation of Land Act Amendment Act, 1900," with

respect to decisions on points of law of the Assessment Court constituted under that Act.

(3.) Section thirty-four of "The Rating Act, 1894," is hereby Repeal. repealed.
