A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Rating Acts.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating Acts Amendment Act, 1889." Short Title.

2. Lands and buildings used for the purposes of any school which is not carried on for pecuniary gain or profit shall not be rateable property under "The Rating Act, 1876." Schools within boroughs exempt from rates.
