A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Representation Act, 1887."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Representation Acts Amendment Act, 1890." Short Title.

10 2. Notwithstanding any existing law to the contrary, any Proclamation or Proclamations which have been issued by the Governor in the *Government Gazette* proclaiming the report or reports of the Commission fixing the names and boundaries of the new electoral districts fixed by them, shall come into effect days after the approval of the Governor shall be given to this Act. Proclamation of report of Commission.

15 3. Within days after the coming into operation of this Act the Registrar appointed under "The Registration Act, 1879," for each electoral district shall form a new electoral roll for such district in the manner provided by the said Act. New electoral rolls.
