AN ACT to amend "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1889." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1900." Short Title.

2. Section two of "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1889," is hereby amended by repealing the words "twenty-eight per centum" wherever they occur in that section, and substituting in lieu thereof the words "fifteen per centum." Mode of computing quota altered.

3. The aforesaid section two is hereby further amended by repealing in the last proviso thereto the words "seven hundred and fifty," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred." Further alteration in mode of computing quota.
