A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law for regulating the Making and Levying of Rates. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating Act Amendment Act, 1903"; and it shall be read with "The Rating Act, 1894" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. The proviso of subsection eleven of section two of the principal Act and ~~subsection three of section two of "The Rating Act Amendment Act, 1895, are~~ hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. Section sixty-eight of the principal Act, and section four of "The Rating Act Amendment Act, 1896," are hereby repealed. Repeals.
