A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Rating Act, 1894."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating Act Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Rating Act, 1894."

Short Title.

2. (1.) The decision of the Assessment Court constituted under the principal Act shall be final on all objections as to value, but not on other questions.

Decision of Assessment Court final as to value only.

(2.) On all such other questions there shall be a right of appeal, exercisable in the manner and subject to the limitations and consequences prescribed by sections eighteen to twenty-four of "The Government Valuation of Land Act Amendment Act, 1900," with respect to decisions on points of law of the Assessment Court constituted under that Act.

(3.) Section thirty-four of "The Rating Act, 1894," is hereby repealed.
