A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorise the Construction of Extensions of and Ad- Title. ditions to certain Railways.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Railways Authorisation Short Title. Act, 1894."

2. The Governor may, in the name and on behalf of Her Governor may ente 10 Majesty, undertake or enter into contracts for the construction of into contracts for extension of certain extensions of and additions to the railways mentioned in the Schedule railways. hereto to the extent specified in such Schedule.

The cost of constructing such extensions and additions shall be How cost to be paid out of moneys appropriated for that purpose by the General

3. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act authorising the Act to be deemed construction of such extensions of and additions to the railways a special Act. mentioned in the said Schedule within the meaning and for the purposes of "The Public Works Act, 1882," and any Acts amending 20 the same or passed in substitution therefor, which said Acts, so far as applicable, are hereby incorporated with this Act.
