A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorise the Construction of Certain Railways.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Railways Authorisation Short Title. Act, 1901."

2. The Governor may from time to time, in the name and on Governor may behalf of His Majesty, undertake or enter into contracts for the construct certain railways. 10 construction of the railways mentioned in the Schedule hereto to the extent specified in such Schedule.

3. The cost of constructing such railways shall be paid out of How cost charged. moneys appropriated for that purpose by the General Assembly.

4. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act authorising the Act to be deemed a 15 construction of such railways to the extent specified in such Schedule, within the meaning and for the purposes of "The Public Works Act. 1894," and its amendments, which Acts are, so far as applicable, hereby incorporated with this Act.

Schedule.

Name of Railway.	Extent authorised.
1. Greymouth-Hokitika-Ross	An extension from Hokitika to Ross. Length, about fifteen miles.
2. Ngahere–Blackball	From a point at or near Ngahere Station, on the Stillwater-Reefton section of the Midland Rail- way, to the right bank of the Blackball Creek, near the Blackball Township. Length, about two miles and a half.
3. Stratford-Kawakawa	An extension of the Stratford – Wangamomona branch from Wangamomona to the Ongarue Sta- tion on the North Island Main Trunk Railway. Length, about sixty-three miles.
4. Stratford – Kawakawa (Ngaire ballast-pit sid- ing)	A siding from a point on the Stratford-Wangamo- mona Branch Railway in Section 1, Block III., Ngaire Survey District, to Bird Road. Length, about one mile and a half.

Name of Railway.	Extent authorised.
5. Gisborne–Karaka (Kaitera- tahi ballast-pit siding)	A siding from a point on the railway about twelve miles and a half from Gisborne to the gravel- deposit on the bank of the Waipaoa River Length, about half a mile.
6 Helensville Northwards	An extension from a point in Section 74, Block IX., Mahurangi Survey District, to a point or the northern boundary of Section 8, Block XVI. Otamatea Survey District. Length, about twelve miles.
7. Kawakawa – Grahamtown (Kawakawa ballast-pit siding)	A siding from a point on the railway near the Wai harakeke Stream to Kaikohe Road, and thence generally along the road to ballast-quarry in Block XIV., Kawakawa Survey District. Length about two miles.
