A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to Road Boards.

Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Road Boards Acts
Amendment Act, 1904”; and it shall form part of and be read
together with “The Road Boards Act, 1882.”

Short Title.

10 2. On the application of any Road Board in a county wherein
the operation of “The Counties Act, 1886,” is suspended, the
Governor may, by Order in Council gazetted, declare that the pro-
visions of sections three to six of “The Road Boards Act 1882
Amendment Act, 1888,” shall apply to that Road Board, and the
said provisions shall apply accordingly.
