2. Certain provisions of Amendment Act of 1888 may be extended to certain Road Boards.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to Road Boards.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Road Boards Acts Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Road Boards Act, 1882."

Short Title.

2. On the application of any Road Board in a county wherein the operation of "The Counties Act, 1886," is suspended, the Governor may, by Order in Council gazetted, declare that the provisions of sections three to six of "The Road Boards Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1888," shall apply to that Road Board, and the said provisions shall apply accordingly.

Certain provisions of Amendment Act of 1888 may be extended to certain Road Boards
