A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Riccarton Bush Act 1914

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Riccarton Bush Amendment Act 1964, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Riccarton Bush Act 1914.

Board empowered to raise annual sum for maintenance—Section 10 of the Riccarton Bush Amendment Act 1947 is hereby amended by omitting the words “as from the completion of the five annual contributions mentioned in section nine hereof, to levy upon the contributories an annual contribution not exceeding two thousand five hundred pounds”, and substituting the words “as from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, to levy upon the contributories an annual contribution not exceeding two thousand five hundred pounds, and as from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, an annual contribution not exceeding five thousand pounds”.
