A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Council of the Borough of Richmond to sell certain Land in the said Borough. Title.

WHEREAS the land detailed in the Schedule hereto was and is vested under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act, 1881," in the Mayor, Councillors, and burgesses of the Borough of Richmond, in trust for a gravel-pit: And whereas the said land is no longer required for a gravel-pit, and it is expedient that the Council of the said borough should be authorised to sell and convey the said land to a purchaser thereof, and to invest the proceeds of such sale in manner hereinafter set forth: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Richmond Borough Council Empowering Act, 1898." Short Title.

2. The Mayor, Councillors, and burgesses of the Borough of Richmond, by the Richmond Borough Council, may sell the land described in the Schedule hereto by private contract, and the Council of the said borough may execute the conveyance of the said land to the purchaser. Borough Council may sell land.

3. The net moneys received by the Council of the said borough arising from the sale of the said land shall be laid out and invested by the said Council in or towards the purchase of other land as a public recreation-ground in the said Borough of Richmond: Provided such other lands are conveyed to or legally vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and burgesses of the said borough as a public recreation-ground. Proceeds to be invested in purchase of public recreation-ground.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situate at Richmond, in the District of Waimea East, containing by admeasurement 1 acre 3 roods and 23 perches more or less, being part of Section No. 83 on the plan of the said district. Bounded on the north, 450 links, and on the east 422 links, by other part of the said Section No. 83; on the south, 450 links, partly by a right-of-way and partly by other parts of the said Section No. 83; and on the west, 422 links, by a public road.
