A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to

Title.

WHEREAS the control of the Rotokare Domain is at present vested in the Hawera Borough Council, but the Council has no funds to improve the same: And whereas it is therefore desirable to permit the Hawera Borough Council as a Domain Board to lease a portion of the said Rotokare Domain with a view to providing it with funds to expend upon the remainder of the reserve:

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Rotokare Domain Act, 1899."

Short Title.

2. The Hawera Borough Council is hereby authorised and empowered to exercise all the powers vested in a "leasing authority," under the provisions of "The Public Bodies Powers Act, 1887," hereinafter called "the said Act," in respect of the lands described in the Schedule hereto, as fully and effectually as though the same had been vested in the said Council for or on behalf of the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Hawera.

Powers vested in Hawera Borough Council in respect of certain lands.

3. The Hawera Borough Council is hereby declared subject to the provisions of the said Act, as though the Governor, by Order in Council, had so declared, pursuant to the fourth section of the said Act, at the request of the said Council.

Leasing authority.

4. All rents and profits derived by the said Board shall be expended in or about the improvements of the said domain from time to time.

Rents and profits to be expended in improving the domain.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that piece of land, in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement 530 acres, more or less, being part of the Rotokare Reserve, and being Section No. 1, Block XII., on the public map of the Ngairu Survey District. The same is delineated on the plan deposited in the District Survey Office at New Plymouth.
