A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to empower the Rotorua District Council to hold
licences under the Sale of Liquor Act 1989**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Rotorua District Council (Sale of Liquor) Empowering Act 1996.

10 **2. Council may hold licences under Sale of Liquor Act 1989**—The Rotorua District Council is hereby authorised to hold on-licences and special licences under the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 in respect of the following premises owned by the Council:
