RANGIORA DRILL-SHED SITE VESTING.

ANALYSIS.

2. Rangiora Drill-shed and site transferred to Crown. Schedule.

Title. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest the Rangiora Drill-shed Site in His Majesty the Title. King.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Rangiora Drill-shed Site Vest- Short Title. ing Act, 1913.

- 2. (1.) The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby Rangiora Drill-shed 10 vested in His Majesty the King and the Rangiora Borough Council and site transferred to Crown. conjointly, subject however to all charges and incumbrances affecting the same, and the trustees in whom the said property is vested shall, on the passing of this Act, vacate their office.
- (2.) The provisions of subsections two, four, five, and six of 15 section seventy-five of the Defence Amendment Act, 1912, shall, mutatis mutandis, apply to the property hereby vested in the Crown in the same manner as if such property had been vested in the Crown by virtue of the said section.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land, containing by admeasurement 1 rood, more or less, being the lot numbered 17 on the sale plan of the rural section numbered 226A on the map or plan of the Chief Surveyor setting out and describing the rural lands in the Mandeville District, in the Provincial District of Canterbury : commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the said rural section, the said point being 8 chains 50 links from the north-eastern corner of the said section, proceeding thence in a southerly direction along the eastern boundary of the said section a distance of 1 chain, thence at a right-angle in a westerly direction a distance of 2 chains 50 links, the whole forming a rectangular block.
