A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Rangitaiki Land Drainage Act, 1910.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Rangitaiki Land Drainage short Title. Amendment Act, 1913, and shall form part of and be read together with the Rangitaiki Land Drainage Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

- 2. (1.) For the purposes of the principal Act the Minister of Minister of Finance 10 Finance, on being authorized by the Governor in Council so to do, authorized to raise may from time to time raise, on the security of and charged upon the of principal Act. public revenues of New Zealand, such sums of money as he thinks fit, not exceeding in the whole the sum of fifty thousand pounds.
- (2.) The sums so raised shall bear interest at such rate, not 15 exceeding five per centum per annum, as the Minister of Finance prescribes.

(3.) This Act shall be deemed to be an authorizing Act within the meaning of the New Zealand Loans Act, 1908, and the moneys

20 hereby authorized to be raised shall be raised under and subject to the provisions of that Act.

(4.) The sums advanced by the Superintendent of the State Advances Office before the commencement of this Act under the authority of the principal Act shall be deemed to have been raised

25 under this Act, and the total amount hereby authorized to be raised shall be reduced accordingly.

(5.) All moneys raised under this Act shall be paid into the Rangitaiki Land Drainage Account, and shall be expended for the purposes of the principal Act under the direction of the Minister of 30 Lands.
