A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Rabbit Nuisance Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. (1.) Section two of the Rabbit Nuisance Amendment Act, 1918, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection one the words "to the satisfaction of the Inspector" and also the words "in the opinion of the Inspector." Section 2 of Rabbit Nuisance Amendment Act, 1918, amended.

(2.) Section seven of the Rabbit Nuisance Amendment Act, 1920, is hereby repealed. Consequential repeal.
