A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the Continuance of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1882." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** The Short Title of this Act is "The Rabbit Nuisance Act Continuance Act, 1885." Short Title.

2. "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1882," is hereby continued, and shall remain in force until repealed by Act of the General Assembly. "Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1882," made perpetual.

 Sections twenty-seven and forty of the said Act are hereby repealed.
