(2.) Every alien who attains the age of fifteen years after the passing of this Act or his guardian shall, within twenty-eight days thereafter, make application for the registration of that alien as an alien under the principal Act.

5. Section nine of the principal Act shall apply to persons

required to register as aliens pursuant to this Act.

6. (1.) Every alien registered under the principal Act who changes his or her name, whether by marriage or otherwise, shall, within twenty-eight days thereafter, give notice of such change to a Registration Officer under the principal Act.

(2.) Every person who fails to give such notice as herein required shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding

twenty pounds.
