# REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS AMENDMENT.

#### ANALYSIS.

Title 1. Short Title.

Penalty for not registering birth may be recovered within three years.

### A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1875." BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Registration of Births and Deaths Short Title. Act Amendment Act, 1882." It shall be construed with and be deemed to be incorporated with "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1875" (herein referred to as "the said Act").

## BIRTHS.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act to the contrary, any Penalty for not information heard in a summary way before two Justices of the Peace for or registering birth may be recovered within in respect of any offence against the sixteenth section of the said Act for non-three years. registration of the birth of any child born in the colony may be laid at any time within three years after the birth of such child, and not afterwards.

#### DEATHS. 15

3. Among other particulars required for the registration of the death of any Ages of living children of deceased person deceased, there shall be registered the age, at the death of the deceased, to be registered. of every living child of such deceased person.

4. Schedule B of the said Act is hereby amended by the insertion of the Schedule B amended 20 words "number, age, and sex," in lieu of the words "number and sex," in as to particulars of registration. the eleventh column of the said Schedule.
