A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Operation of "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act Amendment Act, 1882," in certain Cases. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Registration of Births Extension Act, 1901." Short Title.

2. "The Registration of Births Extension Act, 1889," is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is hereby declared that the provisions of section two of "The Registration of Births and Deaths Act Amendment Act, 1882," shall be extended to include any child born in the colony previous to the period of two years before the passing of this Act; and all other the provisions of the said section, so far as applicable, are hereby re-enacted, and shall extend and apply to this Act accordingly.
