2. Amendment of section 31, "The Regulation
of Local Elections Act, 1876."

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Regulation of Local
Elections Act Amendment Act, 1903"; and it shall be read together
with "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876" (hereinafter
referred to as "the said Act"). Short Title.

10 2. The said Act is hereby amended as follows:—

(1.) In section thirty-one to strike out all the words after the word
"secretly" in lines three and four to and including the
word "vote" in line four, and insert in lieu thereof the
following: "Vote by making a cross, having its centre
15 within the square opposite the name or names of the
candidate or candidates for whom he desires to vote."

(2.) In the Fourth Schedule of the said Act to strike out all the
words of the Schedule from and inclusive of the letters
"N.B." to and including the word "invalid," and insert
20 in lieu thereof the following: "Number of members to
be elected: *One.* [*Names of candidates arranged in
alphabetical order of surnames.*]"

DIRECTIONS.

The voter is to make a cross (X), having its centre within the square opposite the name or names of the candidate or candidates for whom he desires to vote.
