Title. 1. Short Title. 2. Maximum speed-limits of vehicles on public highways.

A BILL INTITULED

- An Act to provide for the Safety of Users of Public Title. Highways by fixing Maximum Speed - limits for Vehicles used thereon.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
 - 1. This Act may be cited as the Regulation of Speed Short Title. of Vehicles Act, 1932.
- 10 2. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any Maximum Act, or in any regulation, rule, by-law, or other act of speed-limits of vehicles on authority thereunder, no person shall drive or cause to public be driven any vehicle of any kind whatever on any public highways. highway at a greater speed than—

- (a) Twenty miles an hour in any borough or town 15 district:
 - (b) Thirty-five miles an hour in any county.
- (2) Every person who commits an offence against this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine of 20 twenty pounds.

(3) Nothing in subsection one of this section shall be construed as authority for any person to drive any vehicle at either of the maximum speeds mentioned therein on any part of any public highway in respect of which a lower maximum rate of speed is prescribed by 5 or under any Act.
