## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to extend "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896." Tide. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Rating on Unimproved Short Title. Value Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Rating on Unimproved Value Act, 1896" (hereinafter called "the principal Act").

2. (1.) From and after the commencement of this Act all rates Extension of rating

shall be made and levied on the unimproved value.

(2.) This section shall not apply to the rates mentioned in section twenty of the principal Act, unless the local authority, by special order, declares that such rates shall be made and levied on the

3. Notwithstanding anything in "The Government Valuation Revision of roll. of Land Act Amendment Act, 1900," or in any other Act, to the contrary, the capital value of land appearing on any district valuationroll shall not be altered except as provided by subsection three of 20 section eleven of that Act until a revision of such roll is made by the Valuer-General; and the Governor in Council may direct such revision to be made at any time.

4. The principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

(1.) As to section three thereof: By repealing subsection one.

(2.) As to section fifteen thereof: By repealing subsection three, and substituting in lieu thereof the following:—

"The rate made and levied by any local authority under this Act shall be so adjusted as not to exceed in its producing-capacity the limit of rating-power on the gross value possessed by that local authority as aforesaid."

(3.) As to section nineteen thereof: By repealing the word "gross," and substituting in lieu thereof the word "unim-
