A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to remove the Disabilities of Women.

WHEREAS women are now possessed of equal voting-powers with Preamble. men, and it is desirable that equal opportunity should be given to 5 them to serve the country in offices which they are competent to fill:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Removal of Women's short Title. 10 Disabilities Act, 1898."

2. From and after the passing of this Act a woman may be Women eligible nominated, appointed, or elected to any public office or position to to any office or which a man may be appointed or elected, any law or statute to the contrary notwithstanding.
