A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Endowment of the Riverton Tille. Public School for the purposes of Higher Education.

WHEREAS it is necessary that provision should be made for the Preamble. proper support of higher education in the District of Riverton, in the Educational District of

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Riverton Public Short Title. School Endowment Act, 1877."

2. The lands specified in the Schedule hereto shall be and remain Lands to be an 10 as an endowment for the support of higher education in the said endowment. Riverton Public School.

3. That until the rents and revenues of the said lands shall be Revenues how to be required for the support of such higher education as aforesaid, they used at present. shall be used and devoted as they are now by law directed.

4. Whenever the Education Board for the Educational District of Revenues when to be 15Southland shall, by resolution, declare that higher education shall be figher education. taught in the said school, the rents and revenues arising from the said lands shall thereupon become applicable and devoted to the sustenance and support thereof.
