 - 1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Restriction Continuance Short Title. Act, 1923.

Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and Eurther extension of the several amendments thereof, in so far as those enactments are duration of law as to restriction of rent. now in force, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and shall then be deemed to be repealed.

(2.) Subsection three of section nine of the Housing Amend- Repeals. ment Act, 1921-22, and section forty-six of the Finance Act, 1922, are hereby repealed.
