A BILL INTITULED

- AN ACT to continue the Operation of Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and its Amendments (relating to the restriction of rent). Title.
- 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—
1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Restriction Continuance Act, 1923. Short Title.
- 10 2. (1.) Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and the several amendments thereof, in so far as those enactments are now in force, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and *twenty-four*, and shall then be deemed to be repealed. Further extension of duration of law as to restriction of rent.
- 15 (2.) Subsection three of section nine of the Housing Amendment Act, 1921-22, and section forty-six of the Finance Act, 1922, are hereby repealed. Repeals.
