### A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to close a Portion of a Public Road known as the Strand, Title.  
Reefton, and ~~set apart~~ vest the same in the Chairman, Coun-  
cillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Inangahua as a Public  
Reserve for Recreation Purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Reefton Recreation Reserve Short Title.  
10 Act, 1909.

2. From and after the passing of this Act the parcel of land Land vested in  
described in the Schedule hereto shall— County of  
Inangahua as a  
public reserve.

(a.) Cease to be a public street or road:

15 (b.) Become and be vested in the Chairman, Councillors, and  
Inhabitants of the County of Inangahua as a public  
reserve for recreation purposes.

### SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land, situate in the Town of Reefton, containing 4 acres or there- Schedule.  
abouts, being portion of a public road known as the Strand, commencing from a  
point 100 links southerly from the south-eastern corner of section numbered 64 on  
the plan of the said Town of Reefton; thence in a southerly direction, bearing  
183° 31', distance 50 links; thence in a south-westerly direction, bearing 255° 10',  
distance 918.1 links; thence in a north-westerly direction, bearing 287° 28' 30", dis-  
tance 1400.7 links; thence easterly, bearing 93° 31', distance 2230.6 links, to the  
commencing-point: and being Section 1338, Block XIV, Reefton Survey District.
